



Kosher products available in Romania:

Dry/shelf products-

- Ketchup - 'Heinz' brand with TK1/2/3/5 on cap
- Mayonnaise - 'Heinz' brand "Seriously Good Heinz" with 8 digits on cap (without spaces or commas)
- Cornflakes - 'Kelloggs' with 
- Tomato sauce - 'Cirio' (Italian brand)
- Tomato paste – 'Freshona' brand
- Pasta – 'Barilla' brand without eggs
- Olive oil – with 
- Sunflower oil
- Coffee with no additives/flavoring
- Rice (check before use)
- Cocoa
- Sugar
- Yeast – 'Dr. Oetker' brand
- Baking powder – 'Dr. Oetker'
- Halva – 'Feleacul' brand (can be found in the Metro)
- Rice cakes – 100% rice/corn
- Black/green tea
- Powdered (confectioner's) sugar
- Flour
- Vinegar ("alimentar de fermentatie alcool etilicrafinat")
- Sunflower seeds – unroasted, unsalted ("crude")
- Eggs – white eggs are better and can be found in large supermarkets, brown eggs have blood spots more often
- Spicy/piquant spices – (no additives/flavoring) such as black pepper and paprika do not need Kashrut sign
- Fruits and vegetables – produce not grown in Israel

Frozen products-

- Frozen chips – 'Farm Frites' "Classic" exported from Holland with production code ending in 010
- Frozen vegetables – without additives, for example:
 - peas
 - beans
 - cauliflower
 - broccoli
 - baby carrots

- chopped spinach
- corn

Fish- (fresh fish)

- Salmon (somon) [smoked salmon is also fine if it's from Norway or Scotland, and as long as there is nothing added besides salt]
- Trout (păstrăv)
- Carp (crap)
- Sea bream (dorada)
- Perch (biban)
- Tuna (ton)

Soy products-

- Soy milk – 'Alpro' brand: classic, chocolate, vanilla, walnut-cocoa and walnut-rice flavors
- Soy pudding – 'Alpro' brand: cocoa, caramel and vanilla flavors

Beverages-

- Beer (no additives/flavoring)
